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
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As you know, our uniform policy is a central part of the school's ethos. Whilst it is our preference to support work with families in adhering to the uniform policy, we would also like to inform you of the possible sanctions for non-compliance with the uniform policy. If a child repeatedly fails to meet uniform expectations, the following steps may be taken:

First instance: A reminder will be issued by a teacher or a member of staff, and the student will be given a chance to correct the issue.

Second instance: Parents will be contacted to discuss the matter and ensure that the uniform policy is followed going forward.



In contrast, we believe in celebrating and rewarding students who consistently meet our uniform expectations. To encourage and acknowledge the positive impact of wearing the uniform correctly, we will be implementing the following rewards:

Weekly recognition: Children who consistently wear their uniform correctly will be praised in assemblies and by their teachers. This may celebrated be with certificates or "School Ambassador" awards.

Monthly prize draw: Children who maintain excellent uniform standards throughout each month will be entered into a prize draw for a special reward, such as a voucher or an extra break-time treat.

Team points: Children who consistently follow the uniform expectations will earn team points, which can contribute to rewards and recognition in our end-of-term assemblies.

We understand that there may occasionally be challenges in meeting these requirements, and we are happy to work with you if there are genuine difficulties in providing the correct uniform. If this is the case, please contact us directly, and we will do our best to assist you.

Please ensure that from the start of Spring Term, your child's uniform adheres to our expectations. Thank you for your continued support in reinforcing the importance of the school uniform.
