NANJIZAL CLASS

This term our topic is called 'The Ancient Egyptians'. In this unit we will learn about the chronology of the Ancient Egyptians, about their civilised way of communicating through hieroglyphics, about some of their most significant gods and goddesses, how and why they built pyramids, about their beliefs related to the afterlife, about how and why they mummified bodies and about their most well known pharaohs.

ATTENDANCE

We are committed to driving our attendance continuously upward. It goes without saying, but the more that your child is in school, the more opportunity they have to learn and progress in all areas.

90% attendance is still 4 weeks off school each year!

80% attendance = 1 day a week off over 5 years = 1 full year of school missed!

Over a year, 10 minutes late each day is 6 full days of school
